Voting shall be by secret paper ballot on a form provided by the Executive Director either in person or by absentee ballot. Absentee ballots may be obtained by completing and submitting the attached Absentee Ballot Request Form to the pension office. Absentee Ballots must be returned to the pension office either by mail or in person no later than 4:30 p.m. on Thursday, June 20, 2019.

Alternatively, "early voting" will be available in person at the pension office beginning on Monday, June 10, 2019 through Wednesday, June 19, 2019 between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.. Photo ID will be required.

As a reminder, in accordance with the provisions of the Code of Ordinances, Elected Officials and Appointees who are members of the Retirement System are not eligible to serve as Trustees or to vote as members of the Plan.
